Bringing Valuable Items to the Centre Policy.

Aim: To achieve harmony and reduce possibility of loss or damage of sentimental valuable items

Rational and Explanation: The Centre is a place for the Children to enjoy themselves, play, and sleep and eat. They wonder (supervised) from one area to another outdoor and indoor, they go to the bathroom and toilet. As staff try to teach them independence and self reliance they are asked to put or bring things in or from their bags and or locker. By time they get to know what to do and when. They are asked to help in packing away and fully interacting with their peers, and staff whether in art, or play. In short they are full mobile all day. This is part of children's learning and development.

In such environment and happening it is unrealistic expectation and demand on the children and Centre's Staff that small such as jewellery, coins, and expensive or inexpensive toys not to be misplaced or damaged, which can lead to misunderstanding and unnecessary disputes and unhappy circumstances.

Implementation: While the staff at the Centre exercises every care as professional in dealing with each and every child and their belongings. It is best if such items not brought to the Centre.
